

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean, James A. Crowell Master.

Friday May 8th 1857

Began with pleasant breezes from the S by E, heading to the Southward, saw a ship at 4 1/2 A.M. bore ship to the N.E. at 6 shortened sail, latter part fine. Course to N to San Diego and Porpoises. Lat 4-47 Long 114-10

Saturday May 9th

Began with pleasant breezes from the S by E, staying S.W. saw squid at 6 P.M. huffed to the wind and shortened sail, latter part fresh breezes at 5 1/2 A.M. bore ship to the N.E. saw Porpoises and one Chin Back. Lat 5-03 Long 105-10

Sunday May 10th

Began with fresh breezes from the E.S.E. heading by the wind to the N.E. at 6 P.M. hoisted the top and main topsails, latter part fine breezes. at 5 1/2 A.M. bore ship to the Southward, saw Porpoises. Lat 4-50 Long 114-18

Monday May 11th

Began with fresh breezes from the E.S.E. equally heading to the Southward, saw squid at 6 P.M. reefed top sails, latter part fresh breezes. at 5 A.M. bore ship to the N.E. saw Porpoises. Lat 5-42 Long 105-28

Tuesday May 12th

First part fresh breezes from the E.S.E. heading by N.E. by N. saw one Chin Back at 6 P.M. shortened sail, latter part fresh breezes, saw Porpoises. at noon tacked to the Southward. Lat 4-15 Long 114-58

Wednesday May 13th

First part fresh breezes from the Eastward heading S.E. latter part fine. saw Porpoises. Lat 5-01 Long 105-09

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Thursday May 14th 1857

First part pleasant breezes from the E.S.E. heading S.E. saw Porpoises, latter part fine. at 4 A.M. bore ship to the Southward.

Friday May 15th

First part pleasant breezes from the Eastward strong by the wind to the Southward. latter part fine. at 1 A.M. bore ship to the Northward. saw Chin Backs. Lat 5-32 Long 105-00

Saturday May 16th

First part pleasant breezes from the Eastward heading N.E. by S. saw Chin Backs. latter part light breezes. at 5 1/2 A.M. bore ship to the S.E. saw Chin Backs. Lat 5-14 Long

Sunday May 17th

First part light breezes from the Eastward heading by the wind S.E. saw Porpoises. at 6 P.M. bore ship to the N.E. latter part light breezes from the N.E. heading N.W. saw Porpoises. Lat 4-54 Long 104-52

Monday May 18th

First part light breezes from the E.S.E. heading to the Northward. latter part light airs. at 1 A.M. bore ship to the Southward. saw Porpoises. Lat 4-45 Long 104-41

Tuesday May 19th

First part light breezes from the S.E. heading to the Southward. saw Porpoises. latter part light airs. at 1 A.M. bore ship to the N.E. saw Porpoises. Lat 4-47 Long 104-52
