Sunday March 31st 1857

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. heading
by the wind S.W. Latter part pleasant breezes
Lat 00-48 Long 110-50

Monday June 1st 1857

Begins with pleasant breezes from E.S.E.
heading S by E by the wind. Saw two fish
and 1 junker. Latter part fine saw one
fin back. Strong weather current.

Lat 1-58 Long 100-53

Tuesday June 2nd

Begins with fresh breezes and some squally
heading S by E. by the wind saw Porpoises.
Latter part fine saw fin backs.

Lat 3-20 Long 101-06

Wednesday June 3rd

Begins with pleasant breezes from the
E.S.E. steering by the wind to the southward.
Saw fin backs, at 4 P.M. went and
sent another bare flap sail. Latter part
fine. at 6 A.M. made sail and started S.W. repairing
sail. Saw fin backs. Our health is not good.
I fear I have some pulmonary complaint coming
on.

Thursday June 4th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the E.S.E. course
S.W. sail mending. at 6 P.M. luffed to
the wind. Latter part fine. four sails in
sight.

Friday June 5th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the
E.S.E. signalized the second. Spoke the
Chili of N.B. 10 months 240 lbs.
Latter part fresh breezes from the E.S.E.
heading to the southward.

Lat 5-21 Long 102-57

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Saturday June 6th 1857

Begins with fresh breezes from E.S.E. heading to the southward
at 6 P.M. wore to the N.E. Latter part fine course S.W. saw
one fin back.

Sunday June 7th

Begins with fine breezes from the eastward. saw a raft and lowered a
boat for it. It proved to be at braving stage, with a pitch pot on it which
we took. it must have come from Callao, a distance of 1500 miles. Latter part
fresh breezes. at 1 P.M. wore to the southward. saw fin backs.

Lat 4-59 Long 103-27

Monday June 8th

Begins with strong winds. heading to the southward under double reef
at 6 took in main sail and jib. Latter part fresh breezes course S.
saw one fin back.

Lat 4-59 Long 103-54

Tuesday June 9th

Begins with fresh breezes and squally, steering N. at 6 P.M.
shortened sail and hipped too. Latter part fine. at 1 P.M. wore
ship. saw Porpoises.

Lat 4-40 Long 104-07

Wednesday June 10th

Begins with pleasant breezes from E.S.E. steering
S by E. at 6 luffed to the wind. Latter part fine.
steering N.W. went the main sail to repair. saw
black fish, Porpoises, and one fin back.

Thursday June 11th

Begins with pleasant breezes, steering S.W. at 4
P.M. finished and sent the main sail. at 6 short-
ened sail and luffed too. Latter part fine course S.
repairing both jibs. saw one fin.

Lat 4-48 Long 105-15

Friday June 12th

Begins with pleasant breezes from S.E. course N.
repaired and sent both jibs. at 6 P.M. shortened sail
and luffed to heading South. Latter part fresh
breezes.
