Saturday June 13th 1857

Begins with fresh Breezes from E. S. E. heading
to the Southward. at 6 P.M. Double Reef and loose
Ship to the S. E. Latter part strong Breezes.
Ship under Reefed Top sails. Saw plenty of Pin
Backs. Lat 4-35 Long 106-00

Sunday June 14th

Begins with strong Breezes from the Eastward
heading by the wind to the S. E. Saw Pin
Backs. The ship has about 600 hundred
stroke in 24 hours. It is something that has
started since leaving Palcahuand and it increases.
A bark ship a dear what a disagreeable thing.
Latter part strong winds. at 1 P.M. wore ship to
the Southward. Lat 4-48 Long 106-13

Monday June 15th

Begins with strong winds from the E. S. E. heading
by the wind to the Southward. under Double Reef.
Latter part strong winds. Steering S.

Lat 5-15 Long

Tuesday June 16th

Begins with strong winds from E. S. E. course
S. E. at 6 P.M. Double Reef. Hoisted the main
sail and heeled to the winds. Latter part strong
winds. at 1 P.M. wore ship to the Southward.
at 6 P.M. wore S. W. Lat Long

Wednesday June 17th

Begins with strong winds from E. S. E.
Steering S. W. at 6 P.M. heeled too.
Latter part strong winds. Steering S. W.
Saw Pin Backs. we are 29 months
out to sea. and my little boy if
living is two years old. I dear how
I should like to see him. and my wife
and other dear friends. But I suppose
it will be two years yet. Lat 4-43
