Begins with strong breezes from the S.E.,
course S.W., at 6 P.M. Double Reefed and
buffed to the winds headed S.
Later part strong breezes. Steering N by E.

Friday June 19th 1857

Begins with strong breezes from the S.E., steering
S by E, at 6 P.M. buffed to the wind heading
S by W. Later part fresh breezes steering to S.W.,
saw several Chin Boats. Ship taking 1000 One Thousand
strokes in 24 hours. I hope that we are not a going
to have a leaky ship to contend with. But it
looks like it for it increases leak.

Saturday June 20th

Begins with pleasant breezes from S.E. Course
N by E, at 6 P.M. came to the wind heading
N.E. by E. Saw one Chin Boats. Later part
fresh breezes. at 5 P.M. took ship to the
Southward. Saw a sail

Lat 5-12 Long 110-29

Sunday June 21st

Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. heading
S.W. by W. at 12 P.M. took ship and
steered N by E. Later part fresh breezes
Saw Surpases.

Lat 6-26 Long 111-05

Monday June 22nd

Begins with fresh breezes from the S.E.
steering N by E. On mouth is very sore
with Waker. No one but those that have
it as I do, can tell what I suffer by it.
Later part pleasant breezes, saw one Chin Boats.

Lat 6-30 Long 111-15

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Thursday June 23rd 1857

Begins with pleasant breezes from S.E. course
N by E. at 6 P.M. Shortened sail. Later part
light breezes. Saw Chin Boats. Lat 6-00 Long 111-15

Friday June 24th

Begins with light breezes from S.E. heading
by the device to the S.E. Later part strong
breezes. Saw Chin Boats.

Lat 6-31 Long 111-25

Saturday June 25th

Begins with strong breezes from the S.E. heading
N.E. by E. Saw Chin Boats. at 6 P.M. Double Reefed
then and Onizen Pop sails. Later part strong
breezes.

Lat 6-43 Long 109-33

Sunday June 26th

Begins with strong breezes from S.E.
heading N.E. under 1 Reefed Pop sails.
Later part pleasant breezes. Saw Chin Boats

Lat 7-11 Long 109-16

Monday June 27th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E.
heading N.E. Saw Chin Boats. Later part fine

Lat 7-10 Long 108-20

Tuesday June 28th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the S.E.
heading S.E. Later part moderate breezes and
raining.

Lat no etc Long 107-08

Wednesday June 29th

Begins with fresh breezes from S.E. heading
to the Eastward. at 6 P.M. took in Pop and
Onizen Pop. Salant sails. Later part raining.

Thursday June 30th

Begins with strong breezes and squally. heading
by the to the Eastward. Saw Chin Boats.
Later part squally.
