

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean James A. Crowell Master.

Wednesday July 14th 1857

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the southward heading E S E. all sail set. at 6 P. M. took in Capt. Sallan's sails. Latter part fine saw two sails. Lat 00-23 Long 82-29

Thursday July 15th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the southward heading E S E. At 6 P. M. tacked to the westward. One sail in sight. Latter part fine, heading to by S. Lat 00-32 Long 83-19

Friday July 16th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the southward heading to S by the wind. Latter part fine. at 1 A. M. wore ship to the eastward. saw two fish. Lat 00-17 Long 84-09

Saturday July 17th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the southward heading E S E by the wind. Latter part moderate Breezes from the S by S. at 2 A. M. wore ship to the westward. Lat 00-02 Long

Sunday July 18th

Begins with moderate Breezes from S by S. heading by the wind to the westward. saw Pin B. Back. at 6 P. M. wore ship to the E S E. Latter part fresh Breezes.

Monday July 19th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the southward heading E S E. at 6 P. M. wore ship to the westward. Latter part fresh Breezes. Lat 00-34 Long 84-33

Tuesday July 20th

Begins with fresh Breezes from the southward heading to S by S. Latter part strong Breezes. saw two sails. Lat 00-59 Long 86-35

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Wednesday July 21st 1857

Begins with strong Breezes from S E heading S by S. One sail in sight. Latter part pleasant Breezes. saw Black fish. At noon Woods Island bearing west Dist 30 miles in sight. Chose 20 miles to the eastward. Lat 1-29 Long 88-18

Thursday July 22nd

Begins with fresh Breezes from S E heading S by S. at 6 P. M. tacked to the eastward Woods Island bearing N Dist 20 miles. Latter part fine, saw Pin B. Backs and Black fish. Lat 1-28 Long 88-42

Friday July 23rd

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the S E heading E S E. saw Pin B. Backs. Latter part fine. at 6 1/2 hours for Black fish, the boat got one. Lat 1-04 Long 88-04

Saturday July 24th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from S E heading E S E. Latter part pleasant. saw Black fish and boiled but the one we got. Lat 00-52 Long 87-12

Sunday July 25th

Begins with pleasant Breezes from the S E heading E S E. Latter part moderate Lat 00-57 Long 86-12

Monday July 26th

Begins with S by S moderate Breezes from S E heading to the eastward. at 6 P. M. tacked to the S by S. Latter part fine saw Black fish two sails, a schooner and the bark Andrews. saw two Pin B. Backs. a strong N westerly Current. Lat 00-52 Long 87-04
