Wednesday September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1857

First part strong winds from S.E. heading E.N.E. under double reef. Latter part strong breezes. at 5:30 A.M. tacked to the southward. Saw One Chin Duck. Lat 52.4 Long 103-14

Thursday Sept 4<sup>th</sup>

First part strong winds from S.E. heading S.W. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part fine. saw One Chin Duck. My Breast is not right. My cough is most gone but has left a distressing feeling in my throat and Breast. Lat 51-02 Long 103-24

Friday Sept 5<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant breezes from E.S.E. heading N.E. Latter part fresh breezes. at 1 P.M. tacked to the southward. saw Chin Ducks. Lat 5-14 Long 103-12

Saturday Sept 6<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh breezes from the E.S.E. heading by the wind to the southward. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part pleasant breezes. saw a Ship. Lat 4-58 Long 103-14

Sunday Sept 7<sup>th</sup>

First part pleasant breezes from E.S.E. heading N.E. at 5 P.M. spoke the Angel Gibbs. at 9 the Seconda ran down and spoke the Gibbs. Latter part fine saw Chin Ducks. Lat 5-10 Long 103-

Monday Sept 8<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the southward. saw two fish. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part pleasant breezes saw Chin Ducks and One Sail. Lat 4-51 Long

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Tuesday Sept 9<sup>th</sup> 1857

First part fresh breezes from the S.E. heading N.E. & E. saw Chin Ducks and Squirrel. My Breast pleases me considerable. I know not what it will end in, but hope I shall be able to finish the voyage. I have sometimes wished that I was a Virgin. I then should have no one to worry myself about. Latter part fresh breezes. at 5:30 A.M. tacked to the southward. repairing main top. ballant sail. Lat 4-51 Long

Wednesday Sept 10<sup>th</sup>

First part fresh breezes from S.E. heading to the southward. at 4 P.M. bent the main top. ballant sail. saw Chin Ducks and One Sail. Latter part strong breezes. saw Chin Ducks Lat Long 103-17

Thursday Sept 11<sup>th</sup>

First part strong breezes from the S.E. heading E.N.E. saw Chin Ducks. at 3:30 P.M. spoke the Hector. Latter part strong winds. at 1 A.M. were ship to the southward. Lat 4-14 Long 103-21

Friday Sept 12<sup>th</sup>

First part strong winds from S.E. heading to the southward. top sails double reefed. the Hector in sight. at 6 P.M. tacked to the N.E. Latter part strong winds. Hector in sight. My complaints about the same. I have a distressing feeling in my Breast and throat the most of the time with pains in my side and Breast. and under my shoulder blades. there appears to be something in my throat or below that I cannot get up or down. I wish I was at home where I could get something to cure it, or to try it. Lat 4-18 Long 103-31
