Saturday Oct 31st 1857

Moderate Breeze, heading to the westward.
At 4 P.M. wore ship. At 5 spoke the
Barque Ohio Capt. Baker 35 on the 11th of
Dec. whale. Latter part fine.
Lat 45-35 Long 89-35

Sunday Nov 1st 1857

First part pleasant Breezes from the
southward. heading E by S. The Barque in
sight. At 6 P.M. knocked a sick dog in
the boat and threw it over board.
Latter part fresh Breeze. Lat 4-35 Long 88-18

Monday Nov 2nd

Fresh Breeze from the southward heading
E by S. At 4 P.M. same with the Ohio.
Latter part fresh Breeze. Lat 4-21 Long 86-58

Tuesday Nov 3rd

Fresh Breeze from the southward heading E by S.
O dear I wish I was at home.
Latter part pleasant Breeze. Lat 10-58 Long 85-50

Wednesday Nov 4th

Moderate Breeze but squally. heading
E S E. Latter part fresh Breezes.
Lat 10-30 Long 84-48

Thursday Nov 5th

First part fresh Breezes and squally
heading E S E. At 6 P.M. looked to the
westward. Latter part fine. Sighting up
Lip sharks. Saw Porpoises.
Lat 10-00 Long 85-40

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Friday Nov 6th 1857

First part fresh Breezes from the southward
heading to S.W. Employed barometer. Killed
a dog. Latter part squally. at 1 P.M. looked
to the eastward. The ship took 1400 strokes in
14 hours. Lat 10-13 S Long

Saturday Nov 7th

First part fresh Breezes from the southward and
squally. heading E S E. Saw 3 birds. The
first seen for a month past. Latter part
Moderate Breezes. at 1 P.M. wore ship to the
westward. Lat 10-14 South Long 84-40

Sunday Nov 8th

Moderate Breezes from the southward. heading
to the westward. Latter part squally. Saw
one fish. Sunday is as it ought not to be; a
very lonely day. When often I think of home.
Lat 10-14 Long 87-02

Monday Nov 9th

First pleasant Breezes from S.W. heading
S E by E. Latter part squally. At 1 P.M. the
looked to the westward.

Tuesday Nov 10th

First part fresh Breezes and squally. heading
to S.W. Saw one bird. Latter part fine.
Heading to by S. Saw 3 birds & drinking.
Lat 1-12 Long 87-58

Wednesday Nov 11th

First part pleasant Breezes from southward.
Heading to by S. at 4 P.M. looked to the wing.
Latter part fine. Lat 1-37 Long 88-58
