

Ship Napoleon Pacific Ocean James A. Brown Master.

Monday Jan 5th 1858

First part fresh fine weather. heading to the westward. This is Sunday evening the account. I wish I was at home. Latter part winds S.W. raining. At 7 A.M. were ship to the southward. Lat 1-27 Long

Tuesday Jan 5th

First part pleasant breezes from the S.W. heading S.E. saw Porpoises. Latter part fresh breezes from the southward. At 1 A.M. took a ship to the westward. Lat 00-55 Long 84-32

Wednesday Jan 6th

First part fresh breezes and squally. Latter heading westward. Latter part fine. Lat 00-44 Long 85-55

Thursday Jan 7th

First part pleasant breezes from S.W. heading west. Latter part fine. Lat 00-49 Long 87-30

Friday Jan 8th

First part light breezes from the southward. heading to the westward. Latter part moderate. Lat 00-50 Long

Saturday Jan 9th

First part moderate breezes from S.E. heading S.W. Employed stowing oil. At 11 A.M. raised Rovers Island bearing S.W. Dist 30 miles. Lat 00-27 Long 87-50

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Sunday January 10th 1858

First part moderate breezes from the S.E. heading S.W. At 6 P.M. took a ship to the westward. Rovers Island in sight. Latter part fine. At 7 P.M. A.M. raised whales. At 11 P.M. lowered the boats. The whales saw the boats and turned to the windward. More Sunday work. I hope every whale we see Sunday the remainder of the voyage, to go the same way. I want to get home where I can keep Sabbath once more. Rovers Island bearing S.W. Dist 30 miles.

Monday Jan 11th

First part moderate breezes from the S.E. At 4 P.M. returned from chasing without success. Saw Rovers at 1 P.M. Latter part fine. Saw Chin Rovers. Rovers Island in sight Dist 15 miles. Lat 00-33 Long 90-06



Tuesday Jan 12th

Pleasant breezes from the S.W. heading S.W. At 6 P.M. were to the eastward. Rovers Island bearing S.W. Dist 10 miles. Latter part pleasant breezes. Lat 00-41 Long 90-00

Wednesday Jan 13th

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. heading to the eastward. put the boat out on the frames. Latter part squally. At 1 A.M. were ship to the S.W. At noon Rovers Island bearing S.W. Dist 30 miles. Lat 00-50 Long 90-07
