Thursday Jan 14th 1858

First part pleasant breezes from the S.E. heading S.W. At 6 P.M. wore ship to the eastward. Abington's Island bearing S by E 1st 25 miles S. Latter part fine.

Friday Jan 15th

First part pleasant breezes from S.E. heading S.W. At 6 P.M. wore ship to the S.W. Latter part fine.

Lat 20-45 Long 90-37

Saturday Jan 16th

First part fine breezes from S.E. heading S.W. At 6 P.M. wore ship to the S.E. Abington's bearing S to 1st 12 miles. Latter part moderate breezes. Heading S.E. by E.

Lat 14-44 Long 90-07

Sunday Jan 17th

First part moderate breezes from the S.E. heading S.E. We are three hours out at 10 P.M. O. I hope but I will return here to my friends, and Christian society, before another year. Latter part moderate breezes.

Lat 2-02 Long 88-16

Monday Jan 18th

First part moderate breezes from S.E. heading S.E. Latter part fine. At 6 A.M. raised whales. Saw the boats. Struck three, two to the L.B.D. One to the waist. The L.B.D. lost one by sinking. At noon took the others to the ship.

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First part 1 P.M. commenced cutting. At 5 finished. Set the water. 11-11/2 commenced boiling. Latter part Daffling breezes and rain.

Wednesday Jan 20th

First moderate breezes from S.E. and rain. Latter part fine. Lat 2-42 Long 88-32

Thursday Jan 21st

First part Daffling breeze rain. At 5 P.M. finished boiling the whales turned up 52 bbls. Latter part light breezes and fine.

Lat 3-07 Long 88-43

Friday Jan 22nd

First part light airs from the S.E. heading S.E. Saw plenty of porpoises. Latter part light airs and calm.

Lat 3-32 Long 88-20

Saturday Jan 23rd

First part light airs from the Northward heading S.E. Latter part light airs from the W.N.W. steering S.E.

Lat 3-25 Long 88-10

Sunday Jan 24th

First part light airs from the S.W. heading S.E. Latter part light airs. Heading S.E. by E.

Lat 3-05 Long 87-30

Monday Jan 25th

First part moderate breezes from the Southward and squally. Heading S.E. Latter squally.
