Monday Feb 15th 1858

Begins with fresh breezes from the Eastward  
Headsails set by E. Latter part strong breezes and  
squally. Went on Chap. Sailed at the  
Mast and Mizzen. Lat 18-58 Long 118-54

Tuesday Feb 16th

Begins with strong winds from the Eastward.  
Headsails set by E. Latter part squally heading  
S. S. E. under reefed top sails. Lat 18-15 Long 119-16

Wednesday Feb 17th

Begins with strong winds from the  
Eastward heading S. by E. under reefed  
top sails. Latter part more moderate. Lat 18-36 Long 121-44

Thursday Feb 18th

Begins with moderate breezes from the  
S. E. heading by the wind to the S. W.  
Latter part fine. Lat Long 122-03

Friday Feb 19th

Begins with moderate breezes from the  
E. S. E. heading by the wind to the  
Southward. Latter part fine. Lat Long 122-44

Saturday Feb 20th

Begins with pleasant breezes from the  
S. E. heading S. by E. Latter part fine  
heading South. Lat 21-10 Long 122-24

Sunday Feb 21st 1858

Begins with pleasant breezes from E. S. E. heading  
to the Southward. At 1 P. M. a British  
Ship flew into one the Cabin windows, it being up  
at the time. I suppose the light must have  
attracted him. Latter part strong breezes and  
squally. Sunday is a day of gloom with me.  
I say that I think of past happiness that  
I have enjoyed with my friends at home.  
I hope I may yet enjoy their society again.

Monday Feb 22nd

First part of Wind Washington's Dist-  
Gaz, with us is strong breezes from the  
S. E. S. E. heading South under double  
reefed top sails. Last part we load in  
Hawahuan. Latter part fresh breezes.  
Main sail furled. Employed painting  
Ship. Lat 24-29 Long 123-43

Tuesday Feb 23rd

Begins with strong winds, heading S.  
under double reefed mainsail furled.  
Latter part fresh breezes. Employed painting  
Ship in side. Lat 25-44 Long 124-24

Wednesday Feb 24th

Begins with fresh breezes and squally from  
the Eastward, heading S. by E.  
Latter part moderate breezes from E. S. E.  
heading South. Employed painting  
Lat 27-46 Long
