Monday April 5th
Fresh breezes from the Northward.
Watch on liberty. Employed getting
water and Potatoes.

Tuesday April 6th
Light breezes from the Northward

Wednesday April 7th
Light breezes from the Northward

Thursday April 8th
Light breezes from the Northward

Friday April 9th
Light breezes from the westward.

Saturday April 10th
Pleasant breezes from S.W. barouly Employed
in ships duty.

Sunday April 11th
Fine weather. No wind from the Northward.

Monday April 12th
Pleasant breezes from the Southern.
getting ready for sea.

Tuesday April 13th
Pleasant breezes from the Southern.
At 3 1/2 P.M. took our Anchor and went
to the buoy to the Port of St. Pedro de.
Latter part light air from the westward.
Three sails in sight. One being by a
whale.

Wednesday April 14th
Begins with light air from the westward
Shading S.W. At 6 P.M. the wind hauls
to W. more S.W. to the S.W. then sails
in sight. Latter part light breezes from
the Northward and rain. Saw Hump & Backs.
No Obs.

Thursday April 15th
Begins with light breezes from the Northward
and rain. At 4 P.M. the wind hauls to
the westward and cleared off. At 7 P.M.
the hauls back to the Northward. Middle part
Pleasant breezes from N.W. Latter part strong S.W.
and rain. Storing S.W. took in Pop. sails
and double reefed the Pop. sails. At noon shipped
a sea carried away Gang way board and some
of the Bulwarks. Lat S. 31-40 Long 77-30

Friday April 16th
Begins with strong S.W. from the N.W. and
rain. At 1 P.M. took in jib and main sails.
Pop sails double reefed. At 4 P.M. the hauls
to the westward and cleared off. Set jib main
sail and let the reef out of the Pop. sails heading
S.W. Latter part blowing a Gale from the
S.W. have too heading both under close reefed
main Pop. sail and double reefed.
Barometer 29.6 Lat S. 31-04 Long 78-17 Lat Obs 31-52 Long 78-55

Saturday April 17th
Begins with strong Gale from the S.W. heading
S.W. At 4. Wind moderate. Made sail. Latter
part strong breezes from the S.W. Storing S.W.
under full Pop. sails and main Pop. sailant
sail. Barometer 29.55 Lat
Lat S. 31-59 Long 78-35 Lat Obs 31-59 Long 78-38
