

Thursday July 20th 1858.
Moderate Breeze from the Eastward. Course N by E.
At 4 A.M. Sounded and got 38 faths, fine Brown
Sand, and Black Specks. Saw plenty of skits
threw the log work overboard.
The whole day is a bustle. Lat 37-54 Long 72-30

Wednesday 21st
Moderate Breeze from the Southward steering
to the Northward. At 4 A.M. Sounded
and got 38 faths of water.

Thursday July 22nd
Moderate Breeze from the Southward
steering N.E. At 10 Midnight made men take
Light. At 6 A.M. took a severe tempest
from the Northward. At 7 the wind hauled
back to the Southward. At 8 saw Black
Island bearing N.N.E. Dist 15 miles.
