Begins with strong breeze from S.W. heading
S.W. by S. Saw three sails. Latter part strong
winds and rain. Lat 41 Long 75

Remarks On Thursday Oct 29th 145th Day.
Begins with strong winds from the S.W. rain.
Ship under double reef. Latter part fresh breeze from the South heading
to the Eastward. At 10 A.M. made the Island
of Mocha bearing E. & Dist 35 miles
Lat 41-43-41 Long 75-55

Remarks On Friday Oct 30th 145th Day.
Begins with fresh breeze from South. Steering
to the Eastward. At 12 P.M. saw ship Mocha
bearing East Dist 8 miles. Ship's Long 15 miles
to the Westward saw Mocha's Backs.
Latter part strong winds from S.W. heading
S.W. Lat 43-34 Long 77-41

Remarks On Saturday Oct 31st 146th Day.
Begins with strong winds from S.W. heading
S.W. under single reef. Latter part light
breezes. Went to New Fish

Remarks On Sunday Nov 1st 146th Day.
Begins with light airs from the South.
Latter part fresh breeze from S.W. heading
S.W. Lat 45-10 Long 79-20

Remarks On Monday Nov 2nd 146th Day.
Begins with fresh breeze from the South
heading S.W. Saw a sail. took in the foreboat.
Lat 45-20 Long 80-55

Remarks On Tuesday Nov 3rd 146th Day.
Begins with fresh breeze from the Westward.
Heading to the South. Latter part winds to S.W.
Lat 48-12 Long 80-12

Ship Alfred Gibbs. Pacific. towards Cape Horn & Home.
Begins with Wednesday Nov 4th 146th Day.

The Captain is making the S. 1 so as to look
that I cannot write tonight. Darned Jack Spar,
he is the only man that I ever disliked, hated
and liked, and despised. At 1 P.M. Breeze
bales from N.W. steering S.W. by E. at sail
on. Latter part strong bales from N.W.
and rain. Steering S.W. by E. 1/2 S. notes
Baram 199 1/2

Remarks On Thursday Nov 5th 146th Day.
Begins with strong bales from the N.W.
and rain. Steering S.W. by S. 1/2 S. under top
sails. Lat 57. Top M. cleared off.
Latter part a gale from the W. to W. with
heavy squalls. Steering S.W. by S. under whole
top sails. Lat 58-18 Long 88-58

Remarks On Friday Nov 6th 146th Day.
Begins with strong bales from the West
and squalls. Steering S.W. by S. under whole top
sails. Latter part fresh breezes from N.W.
Course E by N. S. at sail Lat.
Lat 58-25 Long 93-55

Remarks On Saturday Nov 7th 146th Day.
Begins with strong winds from N.W. steering
E by N. S. and at sail Lat. 61-5 A.M. made the
Island bearing N. N. E. Dist 16 miles. At noon
Cape Horn bearing N. by E. Dist 35 miles.
There is no vessel that it has been yet. 8 Bar 29 1/2
Lat 56-32 Long 87-55

Remarks On Sunday Nov 8th 146th Day.
Begins with moderate from N.W. and fine. Steering
N.W. at 1 P.M. Cape Horn bearing N.N.W.
Dist 25 miles. Saw a sail steering to the Westward.
Latter strong winds from N.W. heading N.E.
under double reef top sails and 4 reef main
sail. parted one of the bowsprit sprayers.
