Out on the Catches. Saw One Seal. Latter part
light air from the N.W. Saw Hump & Backs.
Shortened Sail to Cruise. Went to Old Store sail.
Barometer 30.40 Lat 37-28 Long 55-38.

Remarks On Sunday Nov 22nd 1482nd Day.
Begins with light breezes from the North
Saw Hump & Backs. Latter part moderate.
Saw Bin & Backs. Barometer 30.40 Lat 37-28 Long 55-38.

Remarks On Monday Nov 23rd 1483rd Day.
Begins with N.E. moderate breezes from
the North heading E.N.E. saw Bin & Backs.
Latter part strong winds from N.W. under
Sabbath Keels.

Remarks On Tuesday Nov 24th 1484th Day.
Begins with strong winds from the
westward and squally heading to the North
under Sabbath Keels. Latter part moderate
breezes from N.W. and fine saw a Bark.

Remarks On Wednesday Nov 25th 1485th Day.
Begins with light breezes from the South
and fine. saw plenty of Hump & Backs all
going to the South. Latter part fresh
breezes from N.W. saw a Bark.

Remarks On Thursday Nov 26th 1486th Day.
Begins with pleasant breezes from N.W. and
fine. Latter part fine.
Lat 33-39 Long 52-13

the River La Platta Province.

Friday Nov 27th 1863. 1487th Day.
Begins with moderate breezes from N.W.
and fine. Latter part moderate breezes
from the South and fine.

Remarks On Saturday Nov 28th 1488th Day.
Begins with light breezes from N.E.
and fine. Saw Killers chasing a whale.
a Hump & Back or sperm whale. Could
tell which. Latter part fresh breezes
N.W. Lat 34-02 Long 57-25

Remarks On Sunday Nov 29th 1489th Day.
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W.
saw a Bark steering to the N.W.
Latter part fresh breezes from the North.
Lat 33-35 Long 49-39

Remarks On Monday Nov 30th 1490th Day.
Begins with fresh breezes from the North
saw a Bark in line. Latter part a gale
from the North. Saw too under close R. Keels
Chain and Mizzen (Sabb. Sails).

Remarks On Tuesday Dec 1st 1491st Day.
Begins with a gale from the North
heading E.N.E. under close R. Keels & P. ap.
Sails & rain. Latter part fresh breezes
from N.W. Course N.E. saw two seals.

Remarks On Wednesday Dec 2nd 1492nd Day.
Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. & the
Course N.E. saw a French ship steering to the S.
Latter part moderate. Lat 32-11 Long 46-32

Remarks On Thursday Dec 3rd 1493rd Day.
First part moderate breezes from N.W.
heading N.E. Latter part moderate.
Lat 31-35 Long 46-32
