Employed in mending the fore sail at son down
Took in all of the light sails put one reef in fore & main
Topsail furlled the Main & foresail & halled up the fore sail
And Lufft to on the Starboard tack

Thursday Oct 11th
Commencies with light wind from N. N. E.
Steering N. W. employed in various duties
Middle & Latter part light wind from S. E. heading
S. E. took in all the light sails & furlled the main
Sail & fore topsail at son down ends this day

Friday Oct 12
Commencies with wind from S. E. blowing very strong
With rain & A heavy sea running heading S. E. W. where
Employed in various duties Middle part more moderate
At 1 O. Clock P. M. set the fore & main topsails & halled
up the fore sail & halled up the main sail & halled up the

Halled up the courses. Lufft up on the wind heading to the
Southward & Eastward so ends this day

Sunday Oct 14th
Commencies with light wind from S. steering from
N. N. E. to S. N. E. At day light made all sail
Employed in various duties saw two sails latter part
Wind from S. At 6 O. Clock P. M. took in all of the
Light sails put one reef in the fore & main topsails & halled
up the courses and lufft up on the wind on the starboard
Tack heading S. by S. So ends this Day

Monday Oct 15th
Commencies with a calm Middle part light winds
From S. by E. At day light made all sail employed
In Lending down & mending the main top sail saw
One sail at half past 1 O. Clock Load down the
Main boat and went on board of her workshop at 4 O. Clock
P. M. heading to the Northward & Eastward took in all of the
Light sails put one reef in the topsails & halled up the courses
At son down S. Ends this Day

Tuesday Oct 16
Commencies with strong wind from N. E. heading N. W.
Tacked ship several times through the day heading N. E.
And N. W. Middle & Latter part light wind from
N. E. heading as before employed in various duties saw one
Sail & out hump back at son down took in the light sails
Main sail & put one reef in the top sail so ends this day

Commencies with strong wind from N. E. heading
By the wind heading S. by E. Latter part light winds saw
Employed in various duties saw Transparencies At son down
Took in all light sails main sail And fore top sail
So ends this Day Lat. Lon.
