By S. At son down took in the mintop galant
Sail & again sail & put one reef in the fore and
main top sails. So ends this day Lat 23. 08 L 34. 33

Friday Oct 19th

Commenced with strong wind from N. Made A.M.
Sail at day light heading E. N. E. & employed
in various duties saw one Whisker back & 1 Fin back
Middle part the same At son down took in the
light sails put one reef in the top sails & furled the
main top sail so ends this day

Saturday Oct 20th

Commenced with light wind from N. Heaving
from N.E. to N. E. by E. Middle and late part the
same saw one sail & some Frampencies employed in
various duties at son down took in the light sails
And halled up the courses steering E. N. E. so ends

Sunday Oct 21st

Commenced with light wind from N. E. & E. from
By the wind heading N. by E. Middle & latter part the
strong wind from E. N. E. heading N. by E. & employed
various duties took in light sail at son down so ends
this days work Lat. Son

Monday Oct 22

Commenced with strong wind from N. E. & E. heading
E. by S. At day light made all sail employed in various
duties saw one Fin back Middle part the same At son
down put one reef in the top sails and took in the main
top galant sail so ends this days work

Tuesday Oct 23th

Commenced with strong breeze E. S. E. heading
N. E. At son down employed in various duties Middle and
latter part the same at son down took in the main top galant
sail so ends this day

Wednesday Oct 24th

Commenced with strong wind from N. E. day light saw
Island of Tinian. It is about 25 miles bearing from
the ship N. E. by E. Employed in breaking out bales
to take on shore for waste latter part wind from E. S. E.
Blowing strong at son down put one reef in the top sails At
Nine o'clock P.M. heavy squall passing over took in all
light sails & put the main sail & 1 Fin back bearing E. N. E. Dis
About eight miles so ends this days work

Thursday Oct 25th

Commenced with strong wind from E. S. E.
At day light stood on to the Island At 4 o'clock land
down the starboard boat & the Capt second mate & 4 boats
crew went in shore to see about the waste came on board
Again at 4 o'clock and stood off and on all day wind
Blowing strong with rain squalls at son down took in the
spanker gib. & fore top sail & so ends this days work

Friday Oct 26th

Commenced with strong wind from N. E. standing
off and on At the Island Middle And latter part
the same watering for a good day in get the water
saw one sail at son down the land bore E. S. E.
Dis. five miles so ends this day

Saturday Oct 27

Commenced with strong wind from N. E. laying
off and on at the Island At 8 o'clock A.M. the Capt
and 4 boats crew went in shore to get some fish at 1
o'clock P.M. came on board again and give up getting
water on account of bad weather could not get the water ashore
And kept the ship off E. employed in various duties

Sunday Oct 28th

Commenced with all sail breeze from N. E. & E. from
E. by W. At day light made all sail saw one sail Middle
And latter part the same at son down put one reef in
the top sails so ends this day

Monday Oct 29th

Commenced with strong breeze from N. E. & E. from
E. by W. Middle & latter part the same employed in various duties
