One reef out the Top Sails and out of the fore Sail saw
one Sail through the day To end At Sun

Tuesday Dec 4th
Commenced with light wind from the Northward
And Eastward steering to Northward & Westward
Employed in lowering Down Oil Middle part
the same saw one Sail through the day To end

Wednesday Dec 5th
Commenced with A strong wind from the
Northward & Eastward steering to the Northward
And Westward Employed in various duties Middle
And latter part the same saw A Steamer and
saw the Bark C. H. Went on board
Off her rigging took in the fore Top Sail at Sun
To end this days work

Thursday Dec 6th
Commenced with A light wind from the
Southward & Eastward steering & Employed in
various duties Middle And latter part the same
saw fin backs through the day took in all
light Sails at Sun down To end

Friday Dec 7th
Commenced with A light wind from the Northward
And Eastward steering by the wind heading Southward
And Eastward Employed in various duties Middle
And latter part the same At Sun down took in
all light Sails To end

Saturday Dec 8th
Commenced with A strong wind from the
Northward And Westward steering to the
Middle And latter part strong wind steering
to the Southward And Westward Employed in
various duties saw fin backs through the day At
Sun down took in the fore Top Sail saw one Sail To end

Sunday Dec 9th 1864
Commenced with A light wind from the Eastward
steering by S. Middle and latter part light
winds & Breeze saw fin backs through the day the
Island in sight At Sun down distance one mile
To end this days work

Monday Dec 10th
Commenced with light wind from the Southward
And Westward steering by the wind heading to the
Northward and Westward Employed in various duties
saw one Whaler flying out Middle And latter
part the same took in all light Sails and one
reef in the Top Sails at Sun down

Tuesday Dec 11th
Commenced with A good breeze from W. N. W.
steering by the wind on the Starboard tack heading
S. W. Employed in various duties saw fin backs through
the day Middle And latter part the same At Sun
down took in light Sails put one reef in the Top Sails
To end this days work

Wednesday Dec 12th
Commenced with A light wind from W. N. W.
steering to the Westward employed in various duties
Middle And latter part the same saw fin backs
through the day To end

Thursday Dec 13th
Commenced with Calm employed in various
duties Middle and latter part light wind from
W. N. W. steering by N. W. N. saw fin backs
through the day at Sun down took in all light
Sails put one reef in the Top Sails To end

Friday Dec 14th
Commenced with A strong wind from the Northward
steering by N. Employed in various duties
Middle and latter part the same saw fin
backs through the day took in the Main
Sail fore Top Sail Gilt & Sprung At Sun
down To end the days work
