Commenced with a good breeze from N.W. by W. Steering N.W. by N. Employed in various duties Saw a number of fin back middle and latter part the same to end

Sunday Dec 16th

Commenced with a good breeze from S.E. Steering N.W. by W. Employed in various duties middle and latter part the same Saw several fin backs through the day took in the jib and I spanker at Son down to end this days work

Monday Dec 17th

Commenced with a good breeze from N.W. by W. Steering by the wind heading N.W. by N. Employed in various duties middle and latter part the same Saw fin backs through the day took in all light sails and the main sail and fore top sail at Son down to end this days work

Tuesday Dec 18th

Commenced with a strong breeze from N.W. by W. Steering by the wind heading N.W. by N. Employed in various duties middle and latter part the same Saw fin backs through the day took in all light sails main sail and fore top sail at Son down to end

Wednesday Dec 19th

Commenced with a strong breeze from N.W. by W. Steering by the wind heading N.W. by N. Saw eight whales two times through the day hoisted down the boats and chased them down on board again without any success took in main sail & fore top sail at Son down to end boat 3.15.2.22.22

Thursday Dec 20th

Commenced with a light wind from the Northward and Eastward Steering to the Northward Westward middle and latter part the same Saw fin backs through the day took in all light sails and put one reef in the fore and main top sails to end this days work

Friday Dec 21st 1866

Commenced with a strong wind from N.W. by W. Steering to the Northward and Eastward Saw black fish at 6 o'clock A.M. hoisted down the boat chased them killed two took them on board middle and latter part a strong gale from the N.E. laying to under fore top sail & staysail & main I spanker hauled up the I Boat at Son down to end

Saturday Dec 22nd 1866

Commenced with a strong wind from N.W. by W. Steering N.W. by W. Under top sail and lower employed in various duties Saw fin backs middle and latter part the same took in the main sail & fore top sail at Son down to end

Sunday Dec 23rd

Commenced with a gale of wind from S.W. Steering to the Northward close reef main top sail and fore top sail and one sail and several fin backs through the day to end

Monday Dec 24th

Commenced with a strong wind from the Westward Steering S.W. by W. Employed in various duties middle and latter part the same Saw fin backs through the day to end

Tuesday Dec 25th

Commenced with a good breeze from the Westward Steering S.W. by W. Employed in various duties middle and latter part the same took in the fore top sail & staysail & main I spanker hauled up the I Boat at Son down to end

Wednesday Dec 26th

Commenced with a light wind from the Westward Steering to the Northward & Eastward middle and latter part the same at 10 o'clock P.M. Saw eight whales hoisted down the boat and chased them home on
