off And on At the Island getting off Water Middle
And latter part the same stood off shore At
Ten down And took in All light Sails

Wednesday Jan 9th
Commenced with A strong wind from N.W. And
Very thick Weather Employed in various duties
Middle And latter part the same the Island and
Light Distance About five miles To Ends

Thursday Jan 10th
Commenced with A Strong wind from the Northward
And Westward laying off & on getting recedes
Took the bark

Friday Jan 11th
Commenced with A light from the Northward
And Westward. Steering W. by S. Employed in various
Duties Middle And latter part the same took
In All light sails At Ten down

Saturday Jan 12th
Commenced with A light breeze from the
Eastward Steering W by S Employed in various
Duties Middle & latter part the same took in
All light Sails At Ten down

Sunday Jan 13th
Commenced with A Good breeze from the North
And Westward Steering W by N Middle &
latter part the same Employed in various
Duties To Ends

Monday Jan 14th
Commenced with A heavy sail from the
The Eastward laying too under fore top Staysail
And main spencer Middle And latter part
the same

Tuesday Jan 15th
Commenced with A Strong wind & A heavy
Sea running from the Northward & Westward
Got the Crossed top Sails At day light

Wednesday Jan 16th 1867
Commenced with A good breeze from the Northward
And Westward Steering W by N Employed in various
Duties Middle & latter part the same

Thursday Jan 17th 1867
Commenced with A light wind from N by W
Steering W.N.W. Employed in mending the
Fore Sail Middle And latter part the same ran
fin back through the day

Friday Jan 18th
Commenced with A light wind from the
Northward & Westward Steering W by S. Employed
in various duties Middle & latter part the same

Saturday Jan 19th
Commenced with A light breeze from N by W
Steering W. N. W. Middle & latter part the
same ran Right W. Wals through the day
Load down the boats & chased them home on
Board again without any success

Sunday Jan 20th
Commenced with A light wind from the Westward
Steering N. N. W. Middle And latter part the
same took in All light Sails At Ten down

Monday Jan 21st
Commenced with A calm Middle & latter part
the same ran on right whale At 10.0 clock
Load down the boats the last board
went on And struck killed
& took him Along Side Commenced
cutting out To Ends

Tuesday Jan 22nd
Commenced with A good breeze from the Westward
Laying too cutting in the whale finished cutting
At 7.0 clock At 10.0 started the works At 5.0
clock Am ran Right Whale through the day going
Very fast to the Southwest To Ends this day
No fish
