various duties Saw several Sails through
the day took in Sail At Ten down for the night

Friday Mar 29th
Commenced with a light breeze from
the Southward & Westward Tacking to wind
Saw like Main Top Sails heading to the
Northward & Eastward Saw two Sails
through the day

Saturday Mar 30th
Commenced & Ends with a strong wind
from the Eastward Made all Sail At
Day light heading E. by N. Saw several
Merchant Ships through the day took in
Sail At Ten down for the night & Home

Sunday Mar 31st 1867
Commenced with a strong breeze from N.E.
Steering to the Northward & Westward Under
Double reef Top Sails & Double middle And
latter part the same took in Sail At Ten
Down for the night

Monday April 1st 1867
Commenced & Ends with a good breeze
from N.E. Steering to the Northward & Westward
Under All Sails Employed in various duties
Spoke the Bark Louisa Shortened sail At Ten
Down for the night & in

Tuesday April 2nd
Commenced with a light breeze from
N.W. by W. Steering to the Southward &
Westward Under Double reef Top Sails
And Tacks Employed in various duties Spoke
Saw At Ten down for the night

Wednesday April 3rd
Commenced & Ends with a light breeze
from N.W. by W. Steering to the Southward
And Westward Under all Sails Employed
In various duties took in Sail At Ten Down
for the night & ends

Thursday April 4th
Commenced & Ends with a light breeze
from the Northward & Westward
Steering E. by S. Heading all Sails Employed
In various duties took in Sail and Sail At Ten
Down for the night & ends

Friday April 5th
Commenced with a light breeze from East
Steering by the wind Heading N.E. by N. by
middle & latter part strong wind & heavy rain
Down Under Close reef Main Top Sails And
Double reef Sails Employed in various duties
through the day took three Sails during the
day & Ends this day Work in
