Thursday March the 15 1866
First part of this day begins with fine weather at 1 P.M. lowered and struck a Whale just to the line and lost him at sunset anchored under Penman. Later part squally rain

Friday March 16
First part of this day begins with calm and squally at dark came to anchor under Myra at 6. All got under weigh and stood out on course so I will this day

Saturday March 17
All this day fine weather cruising for Whale saw a number but they were with St. Louis

Sunday March 18
All this day fine weather Laying at anchor under Myra. Some time from 1 P.M. to 6. Still Edward, B. and I took his line and sangway at 7 went ashore and caught him at 8 came off with him and got under weigh and went on course so I will

Monday March 19
All this day fine weather saw several Whale but could not get hold at sunset came to anchor under Penman at 8. I will this day

Tuesday March the 20 1866
First part of this day fine weather or later part a fresh breeze with squally Edward Buxton is sick again so I will this day

Wednesday March 21
All this day squally weather with rain showers at 6. Still got under weigh and went out on course at sunset came in to anchor saw a number of Whales but could not get near them so I will

Thursday March 22
All this day fine weather got under weigh and went out grazing at sunset came to anchor so I will this day

Friday March 23
All this day a fine breeze with good weather got under weigh and went out on course at 1 P.M. lowered and struck a whale at 3 the Iron broke my boat it at 8 struck another and killed it at sunset took it in tow at 12. With anchor between Myra and Union Feb. 24. St. Louis

Saturday March 24
All this day fine weather at day light got under weigh and went in to chase a bay and out in the whale at 11 P.M. got under weigh and went over to Myra and anchored so I will

Sunday March the 25
All this day fine weather out up the harbor and got ready to sail at 1 P.M. got the working rigging so I will this day
