Still this day fine weather began at anchor at Canon So ended the

Monday April 30
Still this day fine weather at daylight got under weigh and went out at 8 lowered for a swim and calf chase till 12 noon and gave it up at sunset came in and anchored for the night So ended the

Tuesday May 1 1866
Still this day fine weather at daylight got under weigh and went out at sunset came to anchor at Bayne So ended the

Wednesday May the 2
Still this day a fine breeze at daylight got under weigh and ran out to Canon at 3 P.M. squalls of rain at 5 came to anchor So ended the

Thursday May the 3 1866
Still this day a fresh breeze and squally weather at 6 Still got under weigh and went out saw a cow and calf at 10 struck the calf killed the cow and she sank cut in the calf at 4 P.M. went in and anchored the So ended

Friday May 4
Still this day fresh breeze and squally weather went out and cruise as usual at 4 P.M. came in to anchor again the So ended

Saturday May 5
Still this day a fresh breeze but clear weather got under weigh and went out as usual at 3 P.M. came to anchor at Union Pole and boiled out the calf second this week the

Sunday May 6
Still this day breeze at anchor at the Union with a fresh breeze and clear weather in the afternoon all hands ashore So ended the

Monday May 7
First part of this day began with squally weather at 10 Still came to anchor at Myre at 11 it cleared up all hands employed in getting up ballast So ended the

Tuesday May 8
First part of this day a fresh breeze got under weigh and went out as usual at 6 P.M. came to anchor again So ended this day the
