All this day light trade wind
steering W by S with fine clear weather
the So 2 miles

Wednesday May 18
First part of this day begins with
light trade wind and clear weather
steering West North and later part
match the same So 2 miles

Thursday May the 19
First part of this day begins with
moderate breeze all most calm at sea
West by South employed steering and
pointing ship the Leb of San Domingo
bearing 33 1/2 W Dist 13 Miles still
and later part match the same
the So 2 miles

Friday May 20
All this day light and huffing
trade steering West and calm
and Portoric still and later part
match the same So 2 miles
the

Saturday May 21
First part of this day begins
with a light breeze and light squall
of rain at 11 still spoke with
the St. Domingo all the rest of the
day a fine breeze and fine weather
at sunset Mooner Isle bearing 1/2
distance 10 Miles steering West
the So 2 miles

Sunday May 22
All this day light winds and
huffing steering west S W at Midday
bore up 2 W So 2 miles this day

Monday May the 14.
All this day light winds and
fine weather at 9 still spoke in
between Atfingla and Boca Lora
steering S W at 3 P.M. saw black
fish and Killers, lowered and
got one of each took them in
and had two So 2 miles
the

Tuesday May 19
All this day moderate and hot
breeze in same way employed
steering the blubber So 2 miles
the

Wednesday May 20
All this day breeze in same
way at 6 still spoke a fire and
bottle and the fish at 13 saw some
Killers again lowered but did
not get hold of them at 11
P.M. kept off to the S W at 6
calm took in part of the sea breeze
came down again at the Leb and
kept off W S W So 2 miles

Thursday May 21
All this day a fresh trade running
down the South side of St Domingo
the So 2 miles

Friday June 1 1866
All this day light and huffing
and off the western of St Domingo
the

Saturday June 2
All this day light and huffing
and steering S W at 11
and the Leb of Cuba saw nothing
more worthy of note So 2 miles
