Sunday June the 7 1866
All this day light and hazy
air clearing 3 1/2 PM at 5 PM
like ship and anchor. We saw
several vessels so ended
the

Monday June 8
All this day fine weather
running down the Gulf saw
two schools of black fish
for them but did not get a haul
at sunset took in sail for
the night to the house of Cape
La Cruz so ended this day
the

Tuesday June 9
All this day a smart breeze
running down along the River
a big breeze at sunset took
in sail for the night so ended
the

Wednesday June 10
All this day a light breeze
running down the River at
5 PM up a sail to the house
were up at 7 PM a rather
at sunset spoke with the
Schooner Allegre the Capt. was
up here at her took in sail
for the night so ended
the

Thursday June 11
All this day light air clearing
saw two vessels of shore and
two steamers at anchor under the
River at sunset took in sail
for the night saw Transpare
so ended

Friday June the 12 1866
All this day light and hazy
air and calms evening up the
South River of Cape La Cruz
the

Saturday June 13
All this day a light breeze coming
off the River in company with the
3 1/2 River and Allegre and
gramper and a number of
vessels passing at 4 PM had
a thunder squall all the shore
at 10 good weather again so ended
the

Sunday June 14
All this day a fine breeze and fine
weather laying under short sail
off and on the River at 5 PM
saw a school of sperm whales lower
and chase them till dark but could
not get up with them so ended
the

Monday June 15
First part of this day began
with a fine breeze at day light
made all sail and was up all day look-
ing for the whales but could
not find them the later part quite
moderate saw nothing this day
so ended
the

Tuesday June 16
All this day a fine breeze coming
about but saw nothing so ended
the

Wednesday June 17
First part of this day a fine
breeze later part moderate with calms
so ended
