Thursday June the 14 1866
All this day light breeze
saw porpoises twice a boat and
got one So Ende this day

Friday June the 15
All this day light breeze
at 4 P.M. saw black fish
lowered and chased them but
got none So Ende

Saturday June 16
All this day light and hap-
ping wind during at 4 P.M.
bark of French Bark So Ende

Sunday June 17
All this day light and warm
calm in morning with the Allegh-
nie saw a Philadelphia Brig
saw at 7 P.M. sent about to
the Bark Trinity of Boston
and got a few papers So Ende

Monday June 18
First part of this day at
a light breeze at 6 A.M. saw
Whaler in company with the
Alleghanie lowered got two ap-
pears at 3 P.M. saw them to the
Westward lowered but did not
see them after So Ende

Tuesday June 19
All this day good weather
employed taking care of oil light
and happy wind So Ende

Journal Continued
Wednesday June the 20 1866
First part a great breeze and rough
later part moderate at 10 A.M. finished
hauling down and clearing up
the So Ende this day

Thursday June 21
All this day fine weather with light
and happy wind saw nothing of
note So Ende this day

Friday June 22
All this day fine weather evening
saw number of vessels passing
saw nothing else worthy of note
at sunset had a thunder squall from
the South So Ende this day

Saturday June 23
All this day light and happy
wind at 10 A.M. saw the Alleghanie
chasing black fish ran down and
lowered and chased with her but
could not get hold of 1 Bullman
and hoarse and took up the boat
and cruised the rest of the day out
So Ende

Sunday June 24
First part of this day began
with a light breeze and hazy weather
later part a light sail in company
with the Wm. H. Grazier Alleghanie
and S. L. Right So Ende

Monday June 25
All this day light and
calm at 7 A.M. saw a sperm whale
lowered and chased at 2 P.M. gave it up
and came on board So Ende
