First part of this day began with a light breeze from the S. and clear weather cutting at 4 P.M. freshen cutting the breeze. Middle of day later part calm and clear the still day took the S. wind 37, 38.

Tuesday Aug 28
First part of this day began with a light breeze from the S. and rain falling from 10 to 12 and was heavy at 12 and 13.

Wednesday Aug the 29
First part of this day began with a light breeze from the S. and rain falling from the wind to the North Middle of day later part it broke away some S. wind stirring 40, 41.

Thursday Aug 30
First part of this day began with light rain falling from 2 to 5 P.M. in the afternoon the rattling of the rain continued the same later part a light breeze from the S. 4 to 8 P.M. covered about and was on board of the ship Richard S. Fly 4 1/2 hour from New Bedford to Philadelphia Lat 40 39, 52.
