got under weigh and ran down
to Myra and came to anchor at
Myra with squally weather So

Friday Jan the 29
First part of this day began with
a fresh breeze and squalls laying at
anchor until the forenoon at 1 P.M.
part in the same So ended

Saturday Feb 1 1867
First part of this day a fresh breeze
and squalls laying at anchor till
part the same Later part more
moderate went out on a cruise and
nothing So ended

Sunday Feb 2
First part of this day a fresh
breeze at 1 P.M. came in to
anchor the weather squally
So ended

Monday Feb 3
All this day a fresh breeze and
squalls laying at anchor at
Myra So ended this day

Tuesday Feb the 4 1867
First part of this day began with
a fresh breeze laying at anchor Later part
moderate got under weigh and went out
on a cruise So ended this day

Wednesday Feb 5
All this day fine weather
at 4 P.M. came to anchor at
the Union at day light got
under weigh again and went on
a cruise saw nothing So ended

Thursday Feb 6
All this day fine weather
out cruising saw one Hemphill
chased him three hours
So ended

Friday Feb 7
All this day a moderate breeze
out cruising So ended this day

Saturday Feb 8
All this day a fresh breeze
laying at anchor set up the
sails at 1 P.M. So ended

Sunday Feb 9
All this day a fresh breeze
at 6 A.M. got under weigh
and went out with the
sails to look after the
sloop that she struck some
nothing and came in again
So ended
