First part of this day begins with a fresh breeze and squalls later part good weather at 5 P.M. struck a humpback and he came to anchor in the bay of San Juan

All this day a fresh breeze at 4 P.M. went out on a run and at 11 came to anchor in the bay of San Juan but got same wood at 1 P.M. got under weigh and went up to Myra and came to anchor in the bay of San Juan

Thursday Feb the 21
All this day a smart breeze and rough weather at 5 P.M. the ship struck a humpback at 9 came to anchor with him in the bay of San Juan

Friday Feb 22
All this day fine weather employed cutting and taking out of oil in the bay of San Juan

Saturday Feb 23
All this day good weather employed hauling in the bay of San Juan

Sunday Feb 24
All this day good weather fine weather hauled down and stored up in the bay of San Juan
