All this day moderate with hazy
wind and clear weather saw two
square rigged vessels Sooner Lat 31 20

Saturday May 25
First part of this day a light
air from the S by W bearing to the
Westward saw four vessels and
caught a harems tooth. Middle part
a light breeze for part a fine breeze
steering S by W saw several square
rigged vessels Sooner Lat 34 47

Sunday May 26
First part of this day began
with a fine breeze steering
S by W at 5 P.M. saw a sperm
whaler. Saw several small boats
small ones took them a long
row and took in sail the wind
from the S by W Lat 31, 45 Long 122 27
Middle and latter part a fresh
breeze and rough sea in the whale
with cloudy weather Sooner Lat 32, 12

Monday May 27
All this day cloudy weather and
foggy taking care of oil and several
square rigged vessels Sooner Lat 32 12
