

Journal Continues  
Friday June the 7 1867  
All this day a fresh breeze and  
sunny weather with a thick haze  
and several vessels seen

Saturday June 8<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day began  
with rough and hazy weather the  
wind from the S.W. saw a large  
schooner steaming to the E. S. and  
whaler Middle part matches the  
same Later part the breeze was  
fresh and hazy. Steaming east by S  
So ends Lat 31.48 Long

Sunday June 9<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day beginning  
a fresh breeze from the S.W. and  
hazy weather Middle part more  
moderate with rain Later part  
weather with the wind S.W. So ends  
Lat 31.47

Monday June 10<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day fine weather  
saw a schooner standing to the southward  
Middle and Later parts a fresh breeze  
and squally weather Lat 31.24

Tuesday June 11<sup>th</sup>  
All this day a fresh breeze  
the breeze and squally weather  
So ends Lat 31.00 Long 74.55

Wednesday June 12<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day began with  
a strong breeze from the S.W. and squally  
weather Middle part a fresh breeze and  
at Rebels passing Later part squally weather

Journal Continues  
Thursday June the 13 1867  
First part of this day began with  
a fine breeze and clear weather Steaming  
Middle Lat 31.01 Long 75.30 Middle part  
fine weather at 2 P.M. spoke Sch  
Arizona at 11 saw a schooner at 11  
Lower part saw So ends Lat 31.06  
Long 75.40

Friday June 14<sup>th</sup>  
All this day fine weather with  
the wind to the Eastward in the  
middle and cleared up as much  
as possible So ends this day

Saturday June 15<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day began  
with fine weather commenced  
hailing Later part a little  
more breeze shook the reefs out  
of the main sail and set the  
flying gill So ends Lat 30.39  
Long 77.30

Sunday June 16<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day began  
with a fine breeze and fine  
weather hailing Middle and Later  
parts more moderate So ends Lat 30.15

Monday June 17<sup>th</sup>  
All this day a fine breeze and fine  
weather commenced hailing and cleared  
down the oil was taken off the tank Lat 30  
Long 78.17

Tuesday June 18<sup>th</sup>  
First part of this day began with  
a strong breeze from the Eastward  
steaming to the S.W. Middle and Later parts  
match the same So ends Lat 30.57
