Saturday July the 20 1867
First part of this day fine clear weather with slight breeze from the S.W. all hands employed painting ship. Middle part much the same. Later part squally and raining at 3. Still kept at 3.4 by 2 the wind S.W. the So India Lat 30

Sunday July 21
First part of this day began with squally rainy weather at 8 P.M. the wind shifted to the S.W. blowing by the wind to the eastward. Noon in company at 6 quite clear. Middle and later parts fine weather at 9 Still saw the black churning whale and the sturgeon and tried hard to get to her at 3.40 with in three hours of her but saw nothing So India Lat 31 Long 74.30

Monday July the 22
First part of this day began with slight breeze from the S.W. chasing the Sun at 2 P.M. calm at 3 the light went on hauling her. Middle and later parts squally and from the West were at 3.40 slight squally rain So India Lat 31.40 the

Tuesday July 23
First part of this day began with slight breeze and raining at 3 P.M. it cleared off steering S.W. and later parts only moderate and clear weather So India Lat 32.15 Long 75.30

Wednesday July the 24 1867
All this day calm and very hot all hands employed about the vessel So India Lat 32.15 the

Thursday July 25
First part of this day calm with a heavy swell heaving from the South. Middle and later parts much the same. So India Lat 31.25 Long 76.00

Friday July the 26
All this day a fine breeze from the South with light showers and a number of vessels steering different directions So India Lat 30.00 the

Saturday July 27
All this day a fine breeze with squally showers steering S.W. 71 saw a number of vessels steering different directions pointing the quarter look So India Lat 33.14 the

Sunday July 28
First part of this day began with a fine breeze from the S.W. and clear weather steering S.W. at 4 P.M. saw a whale lower and chased them till dark. Middle and later parts squally at dark took in sail at 7. Still kept off 3.45 2 saw several vessels So India Lat 34.30

Monday July the 29
First part of this day began with a fine breeze from the S.W. steering S.W. Middle and later parts a fresh breeze steering S.W. 2 So India Lat 37.00
