Saturday Aug the 10 1868
First part of this day began
with light and baffling wind. The
first calm and squally. Late in
a light breeze from the S & W. S. 2 miles
the Lat 37, 00

Sunday Aug 11
First part of this day began
with a light breeze from the S & W
with passing clouds at 5 P. M. and
something to windward. Several
boats and went to it. It proved
to be a small whaler and later part
a smart breeze and rain at 11 P. M.
saw 4 whales made sail in chase
of them so I did Lat 37 29 Long 78
the

Monday Aug 12
First part of this day began
with a smart breeze from the
S & W at 1 P. M. several boats
went at 3 P. M. struck a whale
two got the tubular boat
boarded it at 3 got the whole
along side and cut up in the
head. Later part of the day
the other whale and came
up at day light the rising sun
came down and the east came
board about time so I did Lat
the 37, 18

Tuesday Aug 13
All this day fine and went
up A. S. from Baltimore
to Baltimore on place of boats
and taking care of oil. S. 2 miles
Lat 37, 40 W. 41
