Thursday Dec 2nd

at 1 P.M. took our Anchor in Provincetown Harbour and beat out around the race with the wind from N.W. at 3 the light bore N.W. 8 miles at 11 and knight Calm so ends the first day -

Friday Dec 3rd

at 6 A.M. a breeze sprang up from the S. at 10 we left off to go in to the Vineyard at 5 P.M. came to anchor in Monmouth the wind being fresh from the S.W.

Saturday Dec 4th

first part of this day runner, the wind fresh from the S.W. still laying at anchor at 3 P.M. took our anchor and at 6 came to anchor in Harpings Cove Calm at 8 P.M. took our anchor and went to sea the wind N.E. so ends -

Sunday Dec 5th

first part of this day breeze from the N. at 3 P.M. Tacked bore N.E. 12 miles string S.W. at 2 P.M. doubled reefed the Main sail the wind N.W. string S.W. so ends this day -

Monday Dec 6th

first part of this day fine weather at 10 we took out the reef the wind N. string S.W. at 6 P.M. reefed the Main sail runner the wind S.W. string to the S.E. so ends this day -
