Saturday May 7<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather at 6 A.M. took  
our anchor and went out on a cruise at 5  
P.M. returned so ends this day

Sunday May 8<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather laying at anchor  
at Negro Lake evening so ends this day

Monday May 9<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather at 6 A.M. took  
our anchor and went out on a cruise at  
1 P.M. returned so ends this day

Tuesday May 10<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather at 5 A.M. took  
our anchor bound North Royal Charlwick to  
go in the dry dock to stop the leak she is  
leaking 15,000 stokes in 24 hours so ends this day

Wednesday May 11<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather at 10 A.M. came to  
anchor of North Royal Charlwick the Capt. went  
on shore to ascertain when the vessel could go  
in the dry dock and he was informed she  
could go in Monday the 12<sup>th</sup> so ends this day

Thursday May 12<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather laying at anchor at  
Charlwick leaking 15,000 stokes so ends this day

Friday May 13<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather still laying at anchor  
at Charlwick so ends this day

Saturday May 14<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather took a pilot and  
got under way and came around the other side  
of the Head and got her ready to go into the dry  
dock so ends this day

Sunday May 15<sup>th</sup>

all this day fine wather nothing of note  
this so ends

Monday May 16<sup>th</sup>

at 2 P.M. took her into the dry dock  
the vessel leaking 20,000 stokes 24 hours the  
engine pumping the water out of the dock

Tuesday May 17<sup>th</sup>

all fine wather at 8 A.M. the dock dry, examined  
her bottom and found the metal quite good  
on the starboard side foot on 33 shut of metal  
on the port side found a leak in butt of the fore channel  
in the garboard beam the caulking lined out found  
two of the rudder beams broke and the rudder some  
damaged foot three engrain pieces in her bottom  
so ends this day

Wednesday May 18<sup>th</sup>

on being the rudder & repair it and and  
to put on new beams but have got to wait  
for them to be made so ends this day

Thursday May 19<sup>th</sup>

at 2 P.M. in name the rudder and got her ready  
for going out at 3 she parted and we went  
out of the dock and made sail at 4 came  
to anchor of the town so ends
