at 2 o'clock came to anchor in Keweenaw
Bite at 5 o'clock took our anchor and at 10 o'clock
came to anchor in Walrus Hole the wind from
the N.E. at 1 o'clock it being a Gale of
wind from the N.E. both anchors were hauled
at 6 o'clock the wind hauled to the S.W. and abated
to end this day
