Jan 1 Saturday Remarks of the twenty four hours

At three P.M. Lat 38-00 Long 5-18 1/2
have had fine weather all of the first part
wind from the N.W. course S.E. last part
had it calm by times and light variable wind
from E to W so ends the twenty four hours

Jan 2 Sunday Remarks of the twenty four hours

Lat 38-18 Long
the wind began to die out from the North East
and a light wind to blow up from the S.W. and
varies from East to W. by times last part
we had it steady from S.W. a smart breeze
so ends the twenty four hours

Jan 3 Monday Remarks of the twenty four hours

Lat 37-46 Long
the wind has got to be a blowing a fresh breeze
from the Southward at five P.M. took in outer
gib at one A.M. put two reef in the mainsail
at eight A.M. blowing a gale we put two reef in
our mainsail and hauled out the gib and made
everything secure so ends the twenty four hours

Jan 4 Tuesday Remarks of the twenty four hours

Lat 37-40 L
have the wind blowing a real Gale from South

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to S.W. we have layed heading Eastward under
two reefed mainsail most of the twenty
four hours

Jan 5 Wednesday Remarks of the twenty four hours

Lat Long
first part blowed a gale from the S.W. to W.S.W.
at eight P.M. it began to moderate a little and
the wind came more to the westward between eight
and twelve P.M. set jib and topsail heading South
and S by E. with and old head but sea so ends
the twenty four hours

Jan 6 Thursday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at two P.M. Lat 37-00 Long 58-34
all of the first part a good smart wind from the
Westward run of South with our outer jib and main
gib and mainsail and topsail set at eight A.M.
took in topsail and set our mainsail with the
wind N.W. at ten A.M. had to gib our mainsail
over the wind more to the Eastward so ends the
twenty four hours

Jan 7 Friday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 34-30 Long 57-37 1/2
we have a good sailing breeze from the N.E. course
S by W at last part the wind more to the Eastward
some squall of rain so ends the twenty four hours
