at three P.M. Lat 31-30 Long 38-30
a good sailing breeze from the S.E. part of the line and S.W. part of the line last part wind from the South we have put our boat out across quarter and fixed up a boat deck got the coals stowed up out of the fore-castle and had the main topmast planed of smooth and ciled in readiness to put up so ends this day work

Jan 9 Sunday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 31-34 Long 38-46
wind from S.E. to S.W. by times stood part of the day an on track and for the other last part wind S.W. heading S.E. and S.W. by S so ends this twenty four hours

Jan 10 Monday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 30-50 Long 35-28
a good sailing breeze from the Southward was stored S.W. and S.W. by S and S.W. we sent our main topmast up S.W. and did other ships duty so ends this twenty four hours

Jan 11 Tuesday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 28-40 Long 33-37
first part a good sailing breeze from the S.E. course stored S.W. by S and S.E. by W

Jan 12 Wednesday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 28-40 Long 38-31
first part wind very light and variable at four had the wind to come to the North huffling all through the night last part moderate breeze from the S.E. with squalls of rain. been in play in making boats and fixing up boats so ends this twenty four hours

Jan 13 Thursday Remarks of the twenty four hours

at three P.M. Lat 27-11 Long 40-05
first part a good breeze from the S.E. and S.W. course stored until three P.M. by West the stored South for our course have seen some four vessels in sight all through the night and last part fresh breeze with squalls of rain from the S.E. at seven A.M. we tore the canvas of our G.B. so we took it off and took in our soft top sail. have seen two sail from our mast head been in play in doing ships duty and vessel makes a good deal of water in the run of the twenty four hours
