Jan 21 Friday Remarks of the day

a good breeze from the N.E. made sail in Kingston harbour at one P.M. for Bequia Harbour let our anchor go at three P.M. then sent up our foretopmast and cleared up decks so ends this day

Jan 22 Saturday Remarks of the day

a fresh breeze from the N.E. with light squalls of rain all hands employed in doing ship duty we have taken down our jib tacks and repaired them and set them up again and cleared up decks and washed up for Sunday so ends this day

Jan 23 Sunday Remarks of the day

weather clear and warm wind from the N.E. we have been at anchor in Bequia Harbour and our crew have been aft and on foot as the wished so ends this day

Jan 24 Monday Remarks of the day

first part rainy last part more pleasant so that we were all employed in fixing rigging and mending sails and other ship duty so ends this day

Jan 25 Tuesday Remarks of the day

made sail at nine P.M. for Kingston after our men with a good breeze from the North we could get them all came to anchor for the night

Jan 26 Wednesday Remarks of the day

fresh squalls of rain and wind all of afternoon did not come back so we got under way at one P.M. to go to Bequia after two men came back at three P.M. and went up to mount pleasant and shifted two one named Kingston John David's so ends this day

Jan 27 Thursday Remarks of the day

a fresh breeze from the N.E. we got our two men on board at nine and made sail for Bequia came to anchor at one P.M. then we beat the foresail and mainsail and sent an old ones and did other ship duty so ends this day

Jan 28 Friday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the North have been employed in mending our jibs and bent the outer jib and bent our dore and put up and cutting spinnaker for use and did other ship work so ends this day

Jan 29 Saturday Remarks of the day

a very pleasant weather moderate breeze from the N.E. we got our anchor at nine P.M. and went out on a cruise saw one whale but did not lower our boats for it got back to anchor at two P.M. and then washed our vessel all over so ends this day all well
