weather very pleasant wind light from the North we have layed a anchor all day now free to go and can pass shore so ends this day

this day begins with a fresh breeze from the N.E. we made sail at seven A.M. and went out on a cruise did not see anything we anchored at Cannawon at four P.M. so ends this day

Feb 1 Tuesday Remarks of the day

Fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at seven A.M. went out on a cruise saw two whales hauled for one but did not get forat till we came to anchor a Myro at two P.M. took some wood and mended our two Jibs so ends this day

Feb 2 Wednesday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at eight A.M. for a cruise did not see any whale came to anchor under Union Island at four P.M. so ends this day

Feb 3 Thursday Remarks of the day

a fresh wind from the N.E. all day this day made sail at Union at seven A.M. for Myro anchored at Ten A.M. all hard at work a boat ducks mending the main file the boat are that are late coming from home and have put up a lavender stay to the foremast head and other Ship's duty at five P.M. saw two Whales some three miles to leeward of us so ends day work

Feb 4 Friday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at eight and went out on a cruise at three spoke the scho'r B. J. Wright and gave them letters and received letters at five anchored at Cannawon so ends this day

Feb 5 Saturday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at eight A.M. for a cruise saw Blackfish hauled for them did not get any came to anchor in Bequia at three P.M. and Painted our boats the scho'r B. J. Sparks layed at anchor here so ends this day

Feb 6 Sunday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. have layed to anchor all day came on and off from the shore as they wish so ends this day
