at seven A.M. went out on a cruise saw
some eight whales came near to getting
furthest had some squalls of rain we came
to anchor at five P.M. at Myron the scho
Ada McDyer was at anchor the scho
Grace M. Sparks boat got furthest to anchor
and had to cut from her so ends
this day

Feb 10 Thursday Remarks of to day

fresh breeze the N.E. made sail at day
light went out on a cruise saw a swim-
mer of a whale fished for some got near the
one so we hove at it did not fasten
to it came to anchor at Myron at five
P.M. so ends this day

Feb 11 Friday Remarks of to day

a moderate breeze from the North
made sail at day light went out on a
cruise saw some whales did not lower
for them as they were going forth we
came to anchor at Carnasawern at four
P.M. the scho Grace M. Parker layed
at anchor here so ends this day

Feb 12 Saturday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the North made sail
at seven A.M. went out most to sail
back then run back came to anchor
at Myron at ten A.M. with the scho
Ada McDyer and Grace M. Parker
have mended sails and repaired boat
so ends this day

Feb 13 Sunday Remarks of to day

fresh wind and rain from the N.E. have layed
at anchor all day came up from the
shore as they please so ends this day
