Feb 14 Monday Remarks of to day

a fresh wind from the N.E. we made sail at day light and went out on a cruise for whales saw a number but did not take any came to anchor at Cannawar at four P.M. so ends this day

Feb 15 Tuesday Remarks of to day

made sail at day light and went out on a cruise with a good breeze from the North with some rain squalls at nine P.M. we lowered for whales and both boats got fast and killed them both took them to Union Island so ends this day

Feb 16 Wednesday Remarks of to day

a fresh breeze from the N.E. we got to anchor under Bright Rock at two P.M. turned in until day light then all hands was called out to go to work we cut in one whale and part of a another so ends this day

Feb 17 Thursday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. all hands called out at day light and went to work a cutting in our second whale finished cutting on at half past eleven P.M. but put to work a boat did set and by marks a going at three P.M. so ends this day by standing watch and watch at 11 P.M.

Feb 18 Friday Remarks of to day

fresh breeze from the N.E. all hands at work cutting and boiling whale so ends this day

Feb 19 Saturday Remarks of to day

fresh breeze from the N.E. with squalls of rain have been boiling have put down 45 lbs of Oil so ends this day work

Feb 20 Sunday Remarks of to day

finished boiling at three P.M. have put down Oil 65 in all and chased up decks and washed the vessel so ends this day

Feb 21 Monday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light and went up to myn and came to anchor and went to work repairing up things a bent deck that got out of order and got some wood so ends this day

Feb 22 Tuesday Remarks of to day

made sail at day light with a fresh wind and saw some and went out on a cruise saw some whales and some blackfish we anchored in Bay of Biqua harbour at five P.M. a long side of the Brig S. J. Bigelow so ends this day
