Feb 23 Wednesday Remarks of the day

a very good weather with moderate wind
layed at anchor all day firing the vessel
copper and doing other work mended our
main file and Capt mentores to town
to put letter on shore and base if he
had letter by the return Maile did not
send this day

Feb 24 Remarks of the day Thursday

moderate wind to the East made sail
at day light went out on a cruise saw
some whale saw a cow and calf whale
could not get past to more of them we
let our anchor go at 11 AM at half past
eight the John Adair the Leger has taken a
whale today so ends this day work

Feb 25 Friday Remarks of the day

a good breeze from the N.E. made sail
at day light and went out on a cruise
saw some whales lowered for them
but did not take any cow or calf
at five PM at 11 PM so ends this day

Feb 26 Saturday Remarks of the day

weather good moderate wind from the North
we made sail at day light and went out on
a cruise saw some whales and Capt George
Dyer fastened to one in a school of whales

and just as he got him dead I struck the
hull whale at nine AM and the crew came out
at sun set we got a long side of our vessel
at half past seven PM and shaped our course
for Berynia so ends this day

Feb 27 Sunday Remarks of the day

weather very good came to anchor here in
Berynia Harbour at half past one PM
the weather has continued good all day
all hand off and on from shore as they
wished so ends this day

Feb 28 Monday Remarks of the day

weather good made sail at seven AM and
went out on a cruise saw a cow and calf
whale off west key lowered our boats the
Starboard boat made past to the cow
whale and the Starboard boat got past to
the calf killed them both cow sunk
so we had to cut and let her go took the
calf whole a long side took in to Berynia
at came to anchor at one PM then part
took the Starboard boat on shore to fix
where she got stuck on the whale the
rest went to work and cut in the whale
and cleared up decks so ends this day
work
