fresh breeze from the N.E. have been employed in boiling and pumping and putting down oil have put down for 6 P.M. at four P.M. the Gravelly whaler came in and anchored with a cow and calf whale so ends this day

Mar 11 Friday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. with some squall of rain all hand at work putting down oil and clearing up decks at ten P.M. got our anchor and went out on a cruise the Starboard boat got near enough to haul at a whale did not get fast we came to anchor at Cannawan so ends this day by washing of with lye water

Mar 12 Saturday Remarks of to day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw a number of whales hauled for two or three P.M. and the Starboard boat got fast to a small whale and here we anchored at Myre with it so ends this day

Mar 13 Sunday Remarks of to day

a fresh breeze from the N.E. all hand called out at day light to go to work a cutting in the whale all cutting blubber randed up and barrel decks cleared up at five P.M. so ends this day work

Mar 14 Monday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. all hands called out at day light to work a cutting and setting the works a going have cleared up the line and so forth so ends this day

Mar 15 Tuesday Remarks of to day

fresh breeze from the N.E. finished boiling at nine P.M. all hand employed in stowing down oil and clearing up put down 25 P.M. oil have put down at four P.M. the ship the ship came in with a calf whale sunk the cow so ends this day
