fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw some whales did not take any at four P.M. came to anchor in Beguin harbour here to work a piece of black warp and sent down our Tarftopsail and did some painting on the outside of our boat so ends this day

March Thursday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at seven A.M. and went out on a cruise saw some whales did not take any came to anchor at Myro at four P.M. and took the Tarftopsail and shore and our old water tub and cut a new Tarftopsail out of the water tub and finished patching up the whale bone and so forth so ends this day

March Friday Remarks of the day

fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw a cow and calf and bull whale came very near to getting fast to her but did not at sun set came to anchor at Cammaran so ends this day

March Saturday Remarks of the day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw some

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whales did not lower for them have just shed our Tarftopsail we have washed our vessel all over with lime water we came to anchor in Union at four P.M. so ends this day

March Sunday Remarks of the day

wind moderate but an all ground swell bearing into the bay all hands aft and on shore as they please so ends this day

March Monday Remarks of the day

fresh wind with squalls of rain made sail at day light went out on a cruise saw a number of whales lowered for one did not get near we came in to anchor at five at Myro at six the scho'r Adm. Mc Lagan came to anchor with a cow whale so ends this day

March Tuesday Remarks of the day

a fresh wind from the North and N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise did not see a whale and Capt. went on shore at Union for an hour and a half a gunning we came to anchor at Myro at four P.M. so ends this day
