Nov 24 Thursday Remarks of the day

fresh wind and raine the first part made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw some whales did not lower for them came to anchor at three P.M. at Cannavara we finished scraping our mast and shaked down so ends this day marks

Nov 25 Friday Remarks of the day

a fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw some whales lowered for them two times came near to getting past the scho. S. J. Wright boat got past to see the scho. Alleghania boat got past to see and took the iron I think they sank last there. Whale we came to anchor at two P.M. and came up with the main topmast rigging and set it up again so ends this day marks

Nov 26 Saturday Remarks of the day

a fresh breeze from the N.E. made sail from Myra at day light and went out on a cruise at four P.M. we had just got through washing our lines when we saw a whale close by. Bygones we lowered for him and the starboard boat went out to us and struck we soon killed him a small whale we came to anchor in Bequia harbor at half past seven P.M. so ends this day

Nov 27 Sunday Remarks of the day

all hands called out at day light to go to work a cut was in whale we got all in and cleaned up at five P.M. have had fresh wind so ends this day

Nov 28 Monday Remarks of the day

another good breeze fresh have been employed in bailing and other work a boat deck got and cleaned of the works on the deck so ends this day

Nov 29 Tuesday Remarks of the day

a fresh breeze with some raine finished bailing at two P.M. have been to work in the hall cast a boat deck the whole made 30 blip oil so ends this day
