Apr 30 Wednesday Remarks of to day

a very fine day we have put down Oil and washed off our vessel and as yet put down 30 bbls Oil so ends this day

Mon 1 Thursday Remarks of to day

weather good we left Bayview at day light and went out on a cruise saw some whales and lowered but could not get near to them we anchored at Myre at two P.M. so ends this day

Apr 1 Friday Remarks of to day

weather has been very good light wind from the N.E. made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw some whales lowered but could not get any came to anchor at Myre at four P.M. so ends this day

Apr 2 Saturday Remarks of to day

weather good moderate wind from the East went made sail at day light and went out on a cruise saw quite a number of whale lowered for them but could not get near to they were very shy we came to anchor at Myre at five P.M.

Apr 3 Sunday Remarks of to day

a good day weather fine layed at anchor all day came off and on shore as they wished so ends this day all well

Apr 4 Monday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light went out on a cruise saw some whales we went up to Kingsbor at two P.M. put better a line and got some from them by the Hall at five P.M. came to anchor in Bayview Harbour so ends this day

Apr 5 Tuesday Remarks of to day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light went out on a cruise saw some whales did not get any report the scho. Thrives gave him his letter we got two small fish on our drage line at five P.M. came to anchor at Myre so ends this day

Apr 6 Wednesday Remarks of to day

a fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at day light went out on a cruise saw some whales came in to anchor at Myre at five P.M. so ends this day
