April 7 Thursday Remarks of the day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at daylight went out on a cruise saw one or two whales came in to anchor at one P.M. got some whale and took out a cask of oil and put four or five barrels into it stopped some more whale and put it back and did some of the ship's work so ends this day all well

April 8 Friday Remarks of the day

fresh wind from the Eastward with squalls of rain made sail at daylight went out on a cruise saw some whales saw a cow and calf whale and two other whales with them me by them but could not get hold of them came to anchor at Myra at five P.M. and filled three casks with cold water so ends this day

April 9 Saturday Remarks of the day

a fresh wind from the N.E. made sail and went out on a cruise at daylight we saw one whale lowered for him did not get him so came to anchor in Seynia harbour at five P.M. with six other whale on board so ends this day

April 10 Sunday Remarks of the day

wind fresh from the N.E. have layed at

anchor all day our men have been aft and on shore as they pleased so ends this day all well

April 11 Monday Remarks of the day

a fresh wind from the N.E. made sail and went out on a cruise saw some whales lowered for three whales in a school came near to them did not get first at three P.M. we had a squall of wind and rain which tore our fore sail and jib we got to anchor at Myra at four P.M. and unbuttoned our fore sail and bed down but are minded our jib so ends this day

April 12 Tuesday Remarks of the day

fresh wind from the N.E. made sail at daylight and went out on a cruise saw whales did not lower for them spoke the schr *Isaac* gave these letters we came to anchor at Myra at two P.M. and fixed our habitation and so forth the schr *Isaac* took in a small whale so ends this day

April 13 Wednesday Remarks of the day

weather more moderate than we have had it we made sail at daylight and went out on a cruise did not see a spot of a whale we anchored at Myra at five P.M. so ends this day
