

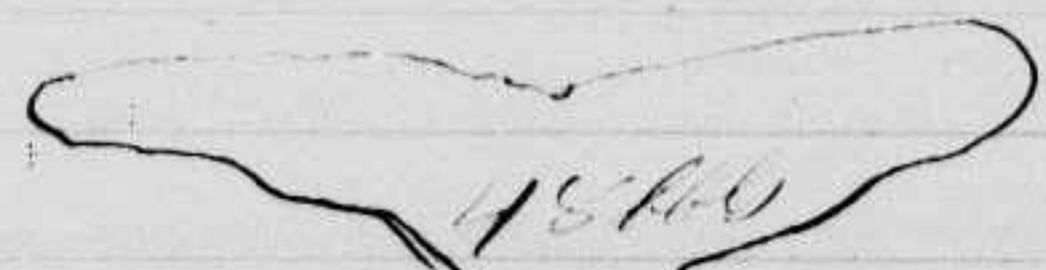
## A Journal Continued

April 14 Thursday Remarks of the day

weather very moderate made sail at day light went out on a cruise saw a large number of Whales we lowered for them a boat at day could not get first we came to anchor at Myre at four P.M. so ends day

April 15 Friday Remarks of the day

at the first part we got under way at eight P.M. with one boat out a head towing it nine we had a light breeze from the S.E. at ten we saw a cow and calf and a bull whale we chased them a boat all day at half past five P.M. we came to anchor at Myre so ends this day



April 16 Saturday Remarks of the day

wind very light from the Eastward made sail at daylight and went out on a cruise at nine A.M. we saw a cow and calf whale lowered for them the Starboard boat got first to the calf and killed the cow before then a long sick at two P.M. and took them in to Myre and got every thing all night and opened the whale and partly picked her the Genl. Stida M. Lys took in a cow and calf whale this morning at four so ends this day work all well

April 17 Sunday Remarks of the day

weather very good we began to cut in at seven A.M. at three P.M. had two boats in as decks and we cut up blubber and stored up deck until dark so ends this day

April 18 Monday Remarks of the day

all hands out at day light set the byworks a going and before 4 o'clock M. M. Sch. Isaac M. Parker came to anchor had a cow Whale on deck that the week Saturday after we cut in at Myre they got both boats shore to Myre so ends this day

April 19 Tuesday Remarks of the day

first part rainy last part better but in played in killing and cleaning out casks and capping cask to put out in the goddell through casting at ten P.M. so ends this day

April 20 Wednesday Remarks of the day

weather good wind quite fresh from the N.E. we have put down Oil 45 bbls and washed the vessel both in and out have cooped a flour cask and did some other work so ends this day
