Monday 19th Calm Employed in boiling at
7 P.M. a light breeze from SE heading SE
a sail in sight bearing E by N. Latter part
finished & washed off Lat 35.18

Tuesday 20th These 24 hours commence with
light winds from SSE at 3 P.M. lowered
for [redacted] O.B. out stuck Lard [redacted]
employed in cutting in [redacted] Lat 35.08

Wednesday 21st Strong breeze from SSE
heading SE employed in boiling Latter part
double reefed Topsails at 9 A.M. lowered
for [redacted] also made the main land of Chile Lat 35.46

Thursday 22nd Employed in boiling Lat 35.59

Friday 23rd Finished boiling and washed off
and made all sail Latter part Laying off
and on at Talcahuana Heads the gig ashore

Saturday 24th These 24 hours commence with calm
Laying off & on bent the chains Latter
part calm and foggy

Sunday 25th Still calm & foggy Laying off
the heads & on part pleasant

Monday 26th These 24 hours commence
with light winds from W & W with
pleasant weather Latter part bent the
chains & beat up to Talcahuana

Tuesday 27th Laying off & on at 5 P.M.
squared away steering NW at 7. double
reefed Topsails Latter part made all
sail stowed chains &c Lat 35.4

down the Coast in March 1849 27
Wednesday 28th These 24 hours commence
with strong breezes from the SSE steering NW
by W & W employed in beating out for
water at 2 P.M. double reefed Topsails Latter
part employed in stowing down Lat 32.11

Thursday 29th These 24 hours commence with
strong winds from SSE steering NW by E and
employed in stowing down at 4 P.M. finished
& washed off Latter part light air made
all sail Lat 30.57

Friday 30th These 24 hours commence
with light airs from SSE steering NW employ
in ships duty Latter part ticked ship
& broke out for water Lat 30.26

Saturday 31st These 24 hours commence
with light winds from NW heading
NW by E Latter part employed in setting
up head stays also made the land in Lat
29.45

Sunday 1st These 24 hours commence with
light winds from SSE steering NW by W
employed in setting up head stays at
4 P.M. lowered for [redacted] Latter part
pleasant Lat 28.19

Monday 2nd These 24 hours commence
with light winds from SE steering NW by E
at 7 P.M. double reefed Topsails
took in Jib & Main sail Latter part
made sail employed in mending Jib
Lat 25.56

Tuesday 3rd These 24 hours commence
with strong breezes from SSE steering NW
by E employed in mending Jib & breaking
out for Meat Bread & water Latter
part pleasant Lat 26.40
