

Remarks on board Ship Nautilus
Saturday 28th Continued. At 6 P.M.
shortened sail. Latter part made sail
L at 3.25

Sunday 29th Still light winds & pleasant
Middle part employed in boiling
Blackfish. Latter part pleasant
Course N by E. Lat 2.04

Monday 30th Light airs & pleasant weather
at 5 P.M. made Good's Island bearing
N by E distant 25 miles at 7 P.M. we
steered N by E. Latter part came to
anchor at Chatham Island

Monday May 7th Sailed. Landing obtained
at Papeete

Tuesday 8th Commenced with light
winds from E & steering E by N employed
in filling & stowing chains & breaking out
for bread at 4 P.M. made Abington's
Island bearing N by E distant 25 miles
also spoke Barque Alfred Ogler Luce 5.
over 150 spurs. Latter part pleasant
Took out for water

Wednesday 9th Running down Game's Island
Sound. Passed several Islands employed
in breaking out the after hold at 6 P.M.
doubtly reefed topsails & luffed to the
wind heading E by E. Latter part made
all sail & made Redonda Rock

Thursday 10th Light airs & pleasant
off Abamail spoke Barque Sappho

Off Gallapagos Islands May 1849
Cushman & Ship Archer Smith of N.
Bedford

Friday 11th Still light airs & variable
passed Barque Lafayette of N. by the S.
& Archer still in sight also saw Black-
fish & took out for meat. Latter part
pleasant

Saturday 12th Light airs & variable
employed in washing ship. Latter part pleasant

Sunday 13th Still light airs beating off
L. Horns the Lafayette & Archer still
in company. Latter part sent a boat in
fishing under North Head

Monday 14th Still light airs 6 ships
in sight. Middle part steady breeze from
E by E. Latter part pleasant

Tuesday 15th Strong breezes from E
& E took in Top & allantails
running down weather bay. Latter part
employed in washing ship

Wednesday 16th Commenced with light airs
from the N by E employed in painting ship
passed a ship standing to the N at 7 P.M.
took in T. & G. sails. Latter part pleasant
made all sail

Thursday 17th Commenced with light airs
from E by E commenced painting L. side
at 5 P.M. spoke Ship Casawba Swain
13 over 350 spurs. Latter part employed
in moving meat aft also made
Vicuna's Island
